In maths we have been weighing and talking about lighter and heavier. We weighed anything we could on a balance.....fruit, teddies, toys and had great fun deciding which was lighter or heavier. We also looked at weighing scales and how we can use them to weigh bigger items such as a melon. If you are baking or cooking and weighing ingredients please let your children watch or join in and talk to them about what you are doing and why. This is an area of maths that cannot be taught through anything other than practical experience and at the moment the children are fascinated by it.

The Early Years children are learning their first sounds and most of them now know what sound is at the start of their name and can identify some sounds from the letters. 'I Spy' is a brilliant game to develop this at home, even though playing at first can seem very random.

In Reception, we are focussing on new sounds every day and practising reading, writing and spelling with these sounds. Your child may bring home some extra practice to help them get these sounds really well. I will put any homework into their book bags so please check carefully.
