## Lunch costs this term will be as follows:



For Y3, Y4 and Early Years the cost is £11.50 per week. £69.00 for the first half of the term, £69.00 for the second half and £138.00 for the whole term.

For y5 and y6 the cost is £13.00 per week. £78.00 for the first half of the term, £78.00 for the second half and £156.00 for the whole term.

All money needs to be sent in to school on a Monday morning in a clearly marked envelope, detailing what you are paying. All cheques, unless advised otherwise, need to be payable to Northumberland County Council. Telephone card payments can be made on Tuesdays.



Milk this term is £10.75 unless your child is under 5 for the whole term or has free school meals. There are some Reception children who will turn 5 this term so please bear this in mind. Any child who paid for milk last term will be charged again this term unless you have spoken to Kathy.

On Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> February, Chinese New Year, we will be having a special Chinese themed lunch. If your child usually brings a packed lunch from home and would like to have lunch that day please let Kathy know, the cost will be £2.30.



Y1 - 4 are swimming this term. There will be a total of 12 swimming lessons this term at a cost of £4.00 per session. . We are very grateful to those parents who pay on a regular basis and would ask those parents that are struggling to at least make a donation.

No earrings are permitted for PE or swimming. Please make sure your child can take their earrings out themselves. A number of pupils have now mastered this. If you are allowing your child to have pierced ears, please take it into Please have a PE kit in school. Always bring a coat. Don't forget swimming on Thursdays. Please stay away from school for 48 hours if you have been sick or have diarrhoea.

Badminton after school on a Monday is now full. There will be 5 sessions of badminton up until half term. Badminton will then move to a Thursday night (6 sessions). On a Monday after half term there will be Rugby for Y3, 4, 5 and 6 (6 sessions) Please give your name to Kathy for the Rugby. Each sports session after school will be £2.50; this can be paid each week or termly.

As you are aware, we trialled after school provision during the autumn term. We are continuing to offer this provision from January 2019, tailored to the needs of the parents who are actually using it. After school club will run on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday until 4.30pm. Tuesday will continue as a construction club, Wednesday will be a craft club and Thursdays will be film night. The older children will be given the opportunity to complete homework or take part in the activities. Charges will be on a sliding scale £5.00 until 4.00pm and £10.00 until 4.30pm. We will review this termly and continue to tailor our provision to your needs, but also to ensure sustainable staffing. If you would like a booking form please let Kathy know.

Provision can still be booked on the day, provided we have other children signed up.

Please make sure your child has a full, warm PE kit in school the weather is getting colder and they will be doing PE outside. Y5 and 6 who are studying dance with Miss Baines need trainers in school, they will not be comfortable dancing in school shoes.
