Milk this term is £13.50. If your child had milk last term it will have been ordered again for the Summer Term, unless you have spoken to Kathy. If your child turns 5 this term, milk will need to be paid for. Please speak to Kathy a.s.a.p. if you want to make any changes. Cheques should be made payable to Northumberland County Council.

The cold sandwich option is back for the summer term. If your child wishes to change we require a weeks' notice.

Lunch costs this term will be as follows. £2.30 per day for Y 3 - 4 and EY's, £2.60 per day for Y5/6

For Y 3, 4 and EY's the cost is £11.50 per week. £66.70 for the first half of the term, £80.50 for the second half and £147.20 for the whole term.

For Y5 and 6 the cost is £13.00 per week. £75.40 for the first half of the term, £91.00 for the second half and £166.40 for the whole term.

All money needs to be sent in to school on a Monday morning in a clearly marked envelope, detailing what you are paying. All cheques, unless advised otherwise, need to be payable to Northumberland County Council. Please do not send money in children's pockets with no indication of what it is paying!



There will be 13 swimming sessions this term for Y1,2,and 3 (\pm 52.00) 6 sessions for Y4 (\pm 24.00) Reception children will have 7 swimming sessions in the second half of the term (\pm 28.00).

 \sim In the second half of term when Reception go swimming Y4,5,6 will have some opportunities to go across to the Forest school.
