Maths

Decimals - hundredths; divide 1 and 2 digits by 10 and 100.

Geography

What did they leave behind?

Understand how climate change affected the first people in Britain; use maps to locate European countries/settlements, relate to prehistoric settlements; understand what the natural environment would have been like during the Stone Age; use OS symbols and 8 points of the compass.

PSHE

Why should we eat well and look after our teeth?

Explore the benefits of eating a healthy diet and the impacts of not having a balanced diet; learn how to maintain good oral hygiene; know how, when and where to ask for advice and help about healthy eating and dental care.
