

It seems likely that the weather is to get cold again. Please make sure your child has a warm waterproof coat, hat and gloves in school. In the event of school bad weather closure, information will be sent by text, and will be on the school and NCC website, Radio Newcastle and the school Facebook page.

Please make sure your PMX Parentmail details are correct. If you have recently changed your mobile number we cannot update your details for you. Texts will be sent out in an emergency so please double check if you are not sure.

## Lunch costs this term will be as follows:



For y5 and y6 the cost is £2.60 per day, £13.00 per week. £75.40 for the first half of the term, £78.00 for the second half and £153.40 for the whole term.

All money needs to be sent in to school on a Monday morning in a clearly marked envelope, detailing what you are paying. All cheques, unless advised otherwise, need to be payable to Northumberland County Council. Telephone card payments can be made on Tuesdays.



Milk this term is £10.70, unless your child is under 5 for the whole term. There are some Reception children who will turn 5 this term, so please bear this in mind. Any child who paid for milk last term will be charged again this term, unless you have spoken to Kathy.

Y3 - 4 are swimming this term. There will be a total of 12 swimming lessons this term at a cost per session, £48.00 for the term. We are very grateful to those parents who pay on a regular and would ask those parents that are struggling to at least make a donation.

No earrings are permitted for PE or swimming. Please make sure your child can take their earrings out themselves. A number of pupils have now mastered this. If you are allowing your child to have pierced ears, please take it into consideration that they need to be able to do this after the 6 week period. If they have only just been pierced, please speak to Kathy if you have not already done so.

Please have a PE kit in school. Always bring a coat. Don't forget swimming on Thursdays. Please stay away from school for 48 hours if you have been sick or have diarrhoea.

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Rugby after school on a Monday has a few places left. There will be 11 sessions of Rugby this term the cost is £2.50 per session, £27.50 for 11 sessions.
