Our Christmas Performances this year will be split. On Wednesday 6th December, Early Years, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 children will perform their nativity, 'Christmas Counts', at 1.00pm and 5.00pm, in school. We would encourage anyone with under 3's to come to the afternoon performance. Both performances will be by ticket only. The evening performance is for adults and children over 3 only. Initially, each family can apply for a maximum of 4 tickets, 2 for the afternoon and 2 for the evening.

'Cindy Wella' our Year 3, Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6 production will be on Wednesday 13th December at 1.00pm and 6.00pm at Lucker Village Hall. We would encourage anyone with under 3's to come to the afternoon performance. Both performances will be by ticket only. The evening performance is for adults and children over 3 only. Initially each family can apply for a maximum of 4 tickets, 2 for the afternoon and 2 for the evening.

If there are any remaining tickets they will be allocated on request, first come first served. All Children at Ellingham Primary School will be expected to attend both performances.
