

Headteacher's Monthly Update

Term Time Holidays

Please can I ask you to always tell us if you are going on holiday, even for one day, as your children always do even if they have been told to say 'they are ill', 'at the dentists' etc. It makes no difference to our attendance figures- they are still absent- and although I can't authorise it, at least it promotes the importance of honesty and saves the children's embarrassment when they enthusiastically tell us where they have been.

Developments

The tendering process for our extension is now complete and I should hear by next week who has been given the revised contract.

We have just learned that the extension of The Duchess' School will not be completed for September 2017; therefore, temporary accommodation will have to be used on the site. Although not ideal, at least this means they are part of the school community and not on a middle school site elsewhere.

Last week, I contacted the HMI Inspector who carried out our monitoring visit to send her current pupil data and School Improvement Plans. She praised out 'succinct plans' and is happy that we should not need any further monitoring visits, but wished us well for our next scheduled inspection.

Our Creative Curriculum Topic for the Spring Term is 'Visual Variety'- see curriculum overview. Year 1 to 5 will be visiting The Shipley Art Gallery next week as part of this project and EYFS will visit the Lego Dinosaur exhibition at Woodhorn Colliery.
