Lunch costs this term will be as follows:



For Y3, Y4 and Early Years the cost is £11.50 per week. £57.50 for the first half of the term, £64.40 for the second half and £121.90 for the whole term.

For Y5 and Y6 the cost is £13.00 per week. £65.00 for the first half of the term, £72.80 for the second half and £137.80 for the whole term.

All money needs to be sent in to school on a Monday morning in a clearly marked envelope, detailing what you are paying. All cheques, unless advised otherwise, need to be payable to Northumberland County Council. Telephone card payments can be made on Tuesdays.



Milk this term is £10.60 unless your child is under 5 for the whole term or has free school meals. There are some Reception children who will turn 5 this term so please bear this in mind. Any child who paid for milk last term will be charged again this term unless you have spoken to Kathy.

Y1 - 4 are swimming this term. There will be a total of 10 swimming lessons this term at a cost of £4.00 per session. We are now subsidising swimming ourselves. We are very grateful to those parents who pay on a regular basis and would ask those parents that are struggling to at least make a donation.

No earrings are permitted for PE or swimming. Please make sure your child can take their earrings out themselves. A number of pupils have now mastered this. If you are allowing your child to have pierced ears please take it into consideration that they need to be able to do this after the 6 week period. If they have only just been pierced please speak to Kathy if you have not already done so.
