Supporting Pupils Learning at Home: Online Learning Platforms

All pupils from Reception to Year 6 have access to a myriad of online learning resources via our school learning platforms.


We use both School360 and Purple Mash. Instructions on how your child can login are below.

Go to our website: www.ellingham.northumberland.sch.uk



Click on pupils, then learning links, to get to the screen above.

If you click on the School 360 link, then the login screen will appear. Pupil in Reception use the EYFS login, all other pupils enter their user name, e.g. fred.bloggs, in the top box and their password, e.g. Legleg12, in the lower box, followed by clicking the login green box. Pupils have login details in their reading records, planners or homework books. All have been tested this week.



This then takes pupils to their own homepage. Depending on the age of your child, their homepage may look different.



For pupils in Years 1-6, to access their Google Drive work folder, pupils need to click on 'My Files' – this takes them to the drive, where they need to click on 'shared with me' on the menu on the left. They should then see the correct class named folder appear, e.g. 'Time Zone', which can then be opened.

The 'Resources' folder on the pupil home screen is where Teachers may direct pupils to for specific tasks


Teachers can put messages for pupils on the message board or screen.
