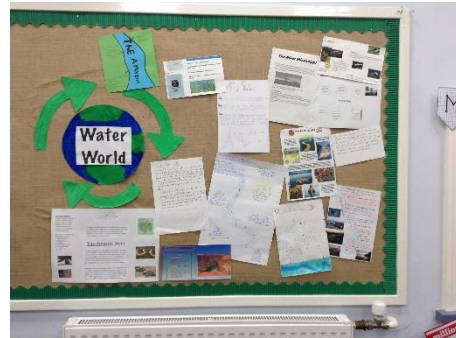


# Time Zone

Our topic this term (until Christmas) is Water World and so far in Geography, we have learned: all about the different features of a river; rivers from the British Isles; as well as rivers around the world.
