This week....we have been so busy. We started practising our Christmas play and everyone decided what character they wanted to be. The script is a big secret and the children are not supposed to give it away. We also picked the pumpkins from the garden that we planted last year and they were still green, but quite beautiful. We hollowed them out and looked at all the seeds and flesh, then made funny faces on them. We have also been learning about spiders and we went on a web hunt to find where the spiders lived around our school. We labelled spider pictures and we made webs and spiders to hang in the den in our classroom.
