Message from Mrs Lakey:

I am really proud of how well everyone is doing at the moment. Thank you for your support in keeping your children off school if they are sick. We are now in full swing for the run up to half term, followed swiftly by Christmas. A gentle reminder that we now start lessons at 8.45am, children can be left at school from 8.30am.
